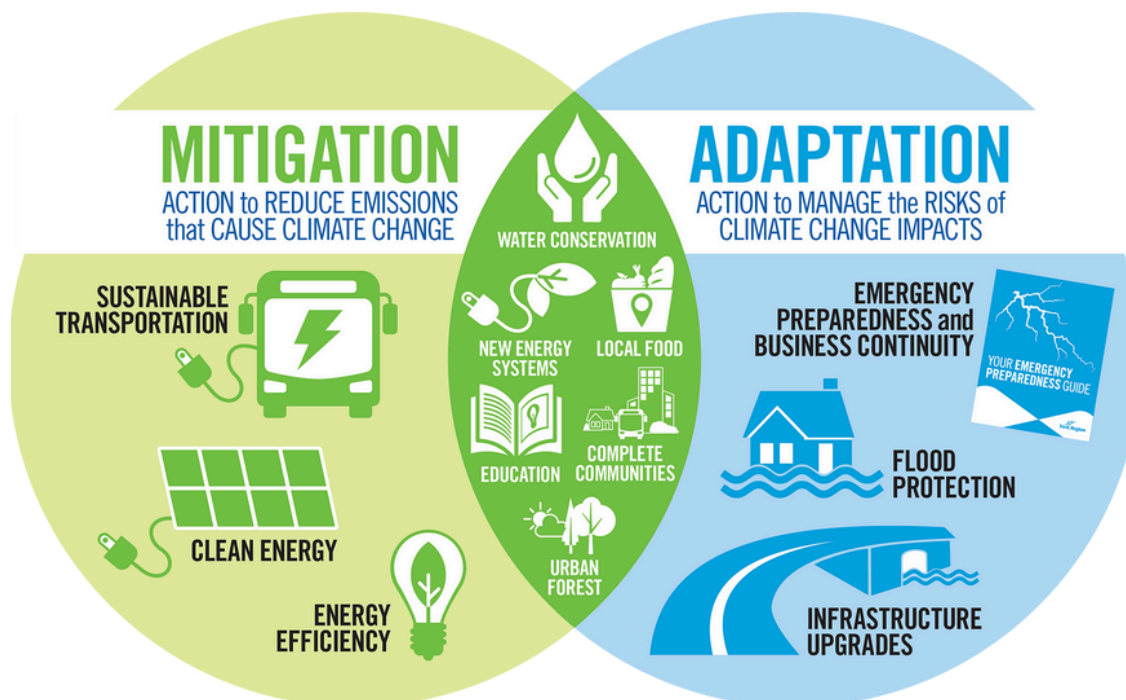

The **Regional Climate Action and Adaptation Plan (RCAPP)** will be the Napa Region's roadmap to prepare for the impacts of climate change and reduce current emissions of greenhouse gases (GHG).

The RCAAP is a collaborative effort led by multiple jurisdictions including the County of Napa, the Cities of American Canyon, Calistoga, Napa, St. Helena, and the Town of Yountville.

By identifying specific strategies regarding transportation, energy usage, land management, and waste disposal to meet GHG reduction goals, we can create a healthier future for the Napa Region.

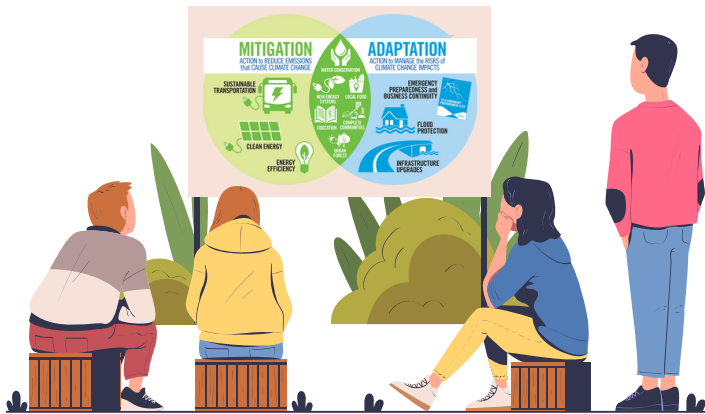
